If you are a motivated adult, 18 years or older, this web-based program offers flexibility to earn a high school equivalency diploma - even if you have a job or other commitments.

The National External Diploma Program (NEDP) enables you to apply the skills you've gained from life and work experience to demonstrate high school level skills. For example, have you:

- Interviewed for a job?
- Compared two different products?
- Looked for information online?

The same skills used in these types of activity can be applied to the online activities required to complete the NEDP!

There is no classroom instruction. Instead, you work through a series of online activities independently **and** with an advisor. These activities demonstrate specific skills such as:

- Reading
- Critical Thinking
- Mathematics
- Writing

- Self-Awareness
- Consumer Awareness
- Scientific Awareness

The program can be completed at your own pace. Advisors are flexible, and will coordinate activities and meetings with you that are convenient for your schedule.

Upon completion of requirements, NEDP students are issued a high school diploma by the New York State Board of Regents. This diploma is recognized by employers and most institutions of higher learning.
